The Financial Risk Manager (FRM®) designation is a globally recognized benchmark certification program for risk management professionals, particularly those who are involved in analyzing, controlling or assessing potential credit risk, market risk and liquidity risk as well as non-market related financial risks.



Certified FRMs are part of a global network (over 32,000 Certified FRMs are practicing worldwide) and are valued by top employers across diverse businesses. The "**Financial Technology Transfer Agency**" (ATTF - www.attf.lu) is proposing a preparation course that will help you to join this community of FRMs and enhance your career!

When and where?

The course "**Preparing to the Financial Risk Manager FRM® Certification Part I of GARP**" (Global Association of Risk Professionals), supported by the **Luxembourg** Government, will be organized in **Luxembourg from 10 to 17 October 2015**.

The course will be held by top-level specialists, **Prof. Georges Hübner** (University of Liège, Belgium) and **Dr Luc Neuberg** (CEO, BCEE Asset Management, Luxembourg), and has been prepared in collaboration with one of the worldwide most well-known specialists in risk management, Prof. Philippe Jorion (University of California).

Who should attend?

The course will be open to **15 participants** selected by ATTF and IFBL/ALRiM experts. The selection will be based on objective criteria such as the applicants' present function as well as their professional and educational background. The geographical location will not be a selection factor. A **very good knowledge of English** is required.

Please note that the 15 selected candidates **will have to sit the GARP FRM® Part I exam by mid 2016**. This exam will take place in different cities on 21 November 2015 and on 21 May 2016. As ATTF has no link with GARP, candidates shall visit GARP website (www.garp.org) to know how to proceed.

In order to ensure that their participation in the course in Luxembourg is confirmed, the selected candidates must send to ATTF:

- the **confirmation of the examination registration and payment** for those who will take the exam in November 2015;
- or an **"affidavit"** in which the candidate commits himself/herself to take the exam in May 2016 (registration will be open at the beginning of December 2015).

We are pleased to inform you that ATTF will **reimburse a part of FRM® Part I exam registration fees** (upon presentation of the exam results) with a **maximum amount of 775 USD**, to those participants who will have **passed** the exam by mid 2016.

We invite you to have a look at the attached documents to get more details on the topics that will be covered during the course and the participation financial conditions.


