CERTIFICATION PROGRAMME RISK MANAGEMENT IN BANKING FOUNDATION LEVEL

With seismic changes continuing to occur in the financial services industry worldwide, an increasing focus is put on identifying and managing risks. It is therefore important for professionals of the financial industry to get a solid foundation in risk management.



To this end, the House of Training (www.houseoftraining.lu) has developed in cooperation with the Luxembourg Association for Risk Management (ALRiM – www.alrim.lu) the **Certification Programme: Risk Management in Banking, Foundation level**.

This course, dedicated to professionals with at least 3 years of experience in a banking environment, can serve as a basis for more advanced courses or as an entry into risk management.

When and where?

The second edition of the Certification Programme: Risk Management in Banking, foundation, supported by the **Luxembourg Government**, will be organized in **Luxembourg from 20 to 29 March 2017** (arrival on 19 March, departure on 30 March).



The course will be held by experts with a deep experience in risk management, willing to share their expertise in this field.

The course will be open to **15 participants** selected by the House of Training/ATTF and ALRiM experts. The selection will be based on objective criteria such as the applicants' present function as well as their professional and educational background. The geographical location will not be a selection factor. A **very good knowledge of English** is required.

Who should attend?

If you are **Risk Manager, Auditor or Department Manager** with a minimum of 3 years of experience in a banking environment, and wish to arm yourself with a solid foundation in risk management, this programme is for you!

By earning the "Risk Management in Banking, foundation level" certificate, you will signal to your employer that you are serious about risk management and that you can objectively demonstrate a standardized level of up-to-date industry knowledge.
