Exam	<p>Once the training has been completed (mandatory attendance to the 8 modules), participants will be registered to the GRI platform to have access to the exam. Further details on the exam and its organisation will be provided during the training: this exam is not hosted by the House of Training / ATTF, and each participant has to register individually. The registration costs will be covered by the ATTF, provided that participants complete the exam within two months after the end of the training course; beyond that deadline, the registration costs will have to be paid by the participant themselves.</p>
